

Important Points to Know: Manners on the Golf Course

Manners When Playing



Please swing your golf club in a safe place.



Please shout "fore" in a loud voice when the ball flies in a dangerous direction.



Please do not spit or discard trash on the course. Please smoke tobacco where there is an ashtray.

- ◆ Please make sure to look after your health. For example, take enough water against rehydration.
- ◆ Please wait until your ball will no longer reach the group in front of you. (Driving is banned.)
- ◆ Please drive a cart with following the precautions by someone with a driver license.
- ◆ Please do not play slowly to have one hole not played between your group and the group before yours.
- ◆ Please fix your own ball marks.
- ◆ Please go to where your ball is with two or three necessary clubs.
- ◆ Please use the restrooms on the course.
- ◆ Please do not hit shots from the putting greens or fringes.

Manners in the Restaurant

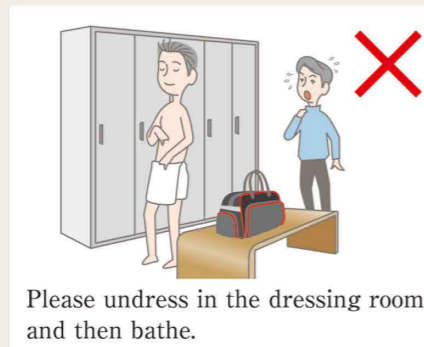


Please do not talk so loudly and refrain from using a mobile phone.



Please do not bring in any food you have brought with you from outside.

Manners in the Bath and Restrooms



Please undress in the dressing room and then bathe.



Please wash your body before entering the bathtub. Please do not put your towel or hair into the water in the bathtub.



You are not allowed to take away items like towels.



You are not allowed to take away items on the premises. Please return items to where you take them from after using them.

- ◆ Please make sure to always flush after using the restroom.
- ◆ Please discard used razors in a wastebasket.
- ◆ Please wipe and dry your body before returning to the dressing room.
- ◆ Please refrain from bathing if you have a tattoo.

Clothes When Arriving

- ◆ Please do not arrive while wearing sandals or shoes with crumpled heels.
- ◆ Please wear an outer garment (jacket or blazer). (Please consult with each golf course in advance.)
- ◆ Please attach your name tag to your caddy bag and Boston bag.

Clothes When Playing

- ◆ Please wear a collared wear regardless of sex.
- ◆ Please wear a cap to protect your head.
- ◆ Please do not wear any towel around your waist or neck.

1 Check-in

Please do not come late and make sure to come at least one hour prior to your start time. You will register yourself and receive your locker key at the reception.

**When Arriving
Do not wear clothes like this!**

- ✗ No jacket and no collared shirt
- ✗ Jeans, casual pants and shorts
- ✗ Sandals or shoes with crumpled heels



2 Locker Room

Change into your golf wear. Please deposit your valuables in your locker or at the reception.



3 Start of the Front Nine

Head to the teeing ground ten minutes prior to your start.

**When playing
Do not wear clothes like this!**

- ✗ No hat
- ✗ Towel wrapped around your waist or neck
- ✗ No collared shirt



4 Lunch Break



When you have finished your front nine, you can enjoy a lunch break in the club house. When entering the club house, please make sure to remove grass and soil with shoe cleaner.

8 Check-out




Please make sure you have not left anything in your locker or the valuables box. Please check-out and pay at the front desk or the automated check-out machine.

7 Bath

6 Hole Out



After holing out, please check the number of clubs you have and make sure you have not left anything behind in the cart.

5 Start of the Back Nine



Please head to the teeing ground with enough time prior to the time of which you were informed before your lunch break.
